# Getting to Slam After Partner's 2 No-Trump Rebid 

## First Principle Here

$\begin{array}{ccccc}\text { North } & \text { East } & \text { South } & \text { West } & { }^{*}{ }^{*} 8 \text { or } 19 \\ 1 & \text { pass } & 1 \boldsymbol{Q} & \text { pass } & \\ 2 n t^{*} & \text { pass } & \text { ?? } & & \end{array}$

- The only way north-south can stop short of game is for south to pass. All responder's bids beyond 2 no trump are game forcing.
- This brings the slow arrival/fast concept into play.
