NO TRUMP SLAM BIDDING 1

 THE GRAND SLAM NEEDS ALL 13 TRICKS AND HAS TO PREVENT THE DEFENDERS MAKING EVEN 1 TRICK.

 THE SMALL SLAM NEEDS 12 TRICKS AND HAS TO PREVENT THE DEFENDERS MAKING TWO TRICKS

THE NO TRUMP SLAMS

• NO TRUMP SLAMS TEND TO BE THE EASY SLAMS BECAUSE THE HCP COUNT IS RELIABLE FOR THE COMBINED STRENGTH OF HANDS.

- GRAND SLAMS REQUIRE 37 HCPS
- SMALL SLAMS REQUIRE 33/35 HCPS

CHECK ON STRONG TWO BIDDING

2NT BID = 20 - 22 hcps

Responses:

- Negative < 4/5 hcps PASS
- Positive 4 to 10 hcps 3NT (or seek major fit)
- Positive 11+ hcps Look for Slam (Quantitative or Gerber)
- (Transfer bid looking for game or slam)

CHECK ON STRONG TWO BIDDING

2D/2H/2S – Guarantees 8 tricks: may be played as Forcing or Nonforcing.

Responses:

- •Negative 2NT < 8 hcps</p>
- Positive 8+ hcps inc an Ace or a King
- Positive only An Ace and a King
- Positive a five card suit inc Ace and Queen minimum.
- POSITIVE = GAME CERTAIN/SLAM POSSIBLE

CHECK ON STRONG TWO BIDDING

2C – 23+hcps or 9+ tricks guaranteed. Bidding CANNOT stop short of 2NT

Responses:

Negative 2D - <7 hcps. The Double Negative 2NT - <2 hcps Positive 7+ hcps with 5/4 card suit headed by Ace or King

Positive 2NT showing balanced 7-9 hcps

Positive 3NT showing balanced 10-12 hcps

Positive jump bid showing AKQJXX

QUANTITATIVE BIDDING

PARTNER OPENS 1NT (12 to 14)

Responses

Flat hand &19/20 points bid 4NT. With 12 points Partner will Pass, with 14 points he will bid 6NT (14 + 19 = 33)

Flat hand & 21/22 points bid 6NT (21 + 12 = 33)

Flat hand & 23/24 points bid 5NT. With 12 points Partner will bid 6NT, with 14 points he will bid 7NT (14 + 23 = 37)

QUANTITATIVE BIDDING

PARTNER OPENS 2NT (20 TO 22)

Responses

Flat hand & 11/12 points bid 4NT. With 20 points Partner will Pass, with 22 points he will bid 6NT (22 + 11 = 33)

Flat hand & 13/14 points bid 6NT (Min 20+13, Max 22+14)

Flat hand & 15/16 points bid 5NT. With 20 points Partner will bid 6NT, with 22 points he will bid 7NT (15 + 22 = 37)

GERBER = NO TRUMP

NO TRUMP SLAMS ARE NOT ALWAYS MADE FROM TWO FLAT HANDS. TO HELP BID A SLAM IT IS SOMETIMES HELPFUL TO KNOW YOUR COMBINED HOLDING OF ACES AND POSSIBLY KINGS.

AFTER PARTNERS OPENING BID **OF 1NT/2NT** WE CAN USE GERBER TO FIND THE HOLDING OF ACES & KINGS. IT IS USUALLY ASSOCIATED WITH A LONG SOLID MINOR SUIT.

4C ASKS PARTNER FOR NUMBER OF ACES. 5C ASKS FOR NUMBER OF KINGS. THIS IS GERBER.

GERBER = NO TRUMP

RESPONSES TO 4C:

- 4D = 0 or 4 Aces
- 4H = 1 Ace
- 4S = 2 Aces
- 4NT = 3 Aces

Note: With Missing Ace(s) sign off in 4 NT

RESPONSES TO 5C:

- 5D = 0 or 4 Kings
- 5H = 1 king
- 5S = 2 Kings
- 5NT = 3 Kings

Note: With Missing King(s) sign off in 5 NT
