Weak 2 Bids

Let's take a look at them!

When one person in the partnership has not yet made a bid and the other person in the partnership JUMPS in the bidding to bid a new suit this bid is called a "PRE-EMPTIVE" bid

You! 2♠

2♠ is a PRE-EMPT. It is a JUMP in the bidding when your Partner has not made a bid.

RHO You!

3 is a PRE-EMPT. It is a JUMP in the bidding when your Partner has not made a bid.

Partner RHO You!

1 Pass 3 Pass

3 is NOT a PRE-EMPT.

Partner opened the bidding.

You! LHO Partner RHO
1♣ 1♥ 1♠ Pass


3 ★ is NOT a PRE-EMPT. You opened the bidding!

To make a "perfect" PRE-EMPTIVE bid you should have the following:

- A LONG suit (6+ cards)
- A weak hand (5/6 to 10/11 HCP)
 - A GOOD suit is best
 - No outside four card major
 - No outside five card suit

The LENGTH in the suit determines the LEVEL you bid at.

With a 6 card suit pre-empt at the 2 level With a 7 card suit pre-empt at the 3 level With a 8 card suit pre-empt at the 4 level



Here is a PERFECT example of a "Weak 2" bid. If you are Dealer open the bidding 2.



If your RHO opens the bidding either 1 - (or 1 + (or 1)) then JUMP to 2 + (or 1) to show this exact hand.



Watch out though -- If your RHO opens the bidding 1♠ then 2♥ is no longer a JUMP. This now shows VALUES since it is a 2 level overcall!




If you want to bid on this hand you will need to JUMP to 3♥ -- but now Partner might think you have seven of them...

Watch out for VULNERABILITY


If you are VULNERABLE then you should have a very nice suit and a somewhat decent hand.

NON-VULNERABLE you should still have a decent suit but it doesn't have to be so good.


How do we know whether or not we are Vulnerable?



You can tell by the colours by the Board Number.



Here N/S are VULNERABLE (the colour RED)



Here E/W are NOT VULNERABLE (the colour WHITE)

Vulnerablity makes a difference because, since you are weak, you might not make your contract.

Vulnerable every down trick is -100 Non-Vulnerable every down trick is -50

If you go down 2 in your contract and you are NOT Vulnerable you give the Opponents 50 pptx2 down tricks or 100 points. (ppt=points per trick)

BUT if your Opponents can make 2♥ they will score 30 ppt x 2 + 50 (Part Score Bonus) for 110 points.

So it is better for YOU to go down 2 in your contract vs the Opponents making their part score contract.

If you go down 2 in your contract and you are VULNERABLE you give the Opponents 100 pptx2 down tricks or 200 points.

If your Opponents can make 2♥ they will score 30 ppt x 2 + 50 (Part Score Bonus) for 110 points.

So it is NOT GOOD for YOU to go down 2 in your contract vs the Opponents making their part score. Vulnerable you can only go down 1.

What does Partner do over a Weak 2?

They should bid game if they think they can make it

They should raise to their LAW level with a weak hand

So they add your trump to their trump and assume that is how many tricks they will take. They will then bid to that level.



What else can Partner do?

Partner can bid a new suit if they have a STRONG hand.

A new suit is FORCING which means the Weak 2 bidder must bid again.

You've got no fit for Partner and a new suit is FORCING. If you bid your suit Partner will probably respond – you guessed it -- 3♥



Yes, you've got no fit and are in trouble but sometimes the only way out of a deep, dark hole is to STOP DIGGING. If you bid, you dig yourself deeper and deeper.



It'll be hard to scrape up 10 tricks. Just Pass.

Last but not least Partner can ASK the Weak 2 bidder if they have an outside Feature.

An outside Feature is an Ace or King that is NOT in the trump suit.

The Responses are...




Bidding 3NT shows a SOLID SUIT – AKQ and says you do not need an Outside Feature!




Bidding another suit shows a maximum hand (8+) and shows where your Outside Feature is!

Bid 3 to show either the Ace or King of

Repeating your suit says you do NOT have a solid suit and you do NOT have an outside Feature



With a weaker hand (5-7 HCP) do NOT show an Outside Feature even if you have one.

You can play another → to set up the suit but there is NO WAY back to Dummy to enjoy your winners!






Now if the Opponents don't win their Ace of ♦ the first time you can always get back to Dummy with the King of ♠



Winners with no additional Entry needed! The Opponents can't hold up on their Ace because they don't have it!

Play High Cards from the Short Side to avoid blocking the suit.



If Partner bids 3♦ you might not want to take a chance on 3NT. Just "Pass"

Game here is just not safe.

If you do bid the game better hope you are lucky or you get bad Defence. Either will work.

What to do over a "Weak 2"

- Bid game with enough values to make game
- Bid 3NT to play
- Bid to your LAW level to disrupt the Opponents
- A new suit is FORCING
- Pass with no hope for game or with no fit
- Bid 2NT to ask the Weak 2 bidder if they have an outside Ace or King

Over a 2NT response the "Weak 2" bidder will:

- Bid 3NT with a SOLID SUIT -- AKQxxx
- With a MAXIMUM, bid the suit where they have an outside Ace of King at the 3 level
- With a MINIMUM or no Outside Ace or King just rebid their original suit
