## Determining the Captain

- In every bidding sequence, there is a team captain.
- The captain will be the person who knows the total values of the partnership first.
- Most of the time it is the responder, but not always.
- The captain determines how high the partnership can go.
- And what the contract (suit or no trump) will be.
