



2♠ Response to 1NT

Three possible uses:

- 1. 2♠ shows a long minor
- 2. 2♠ =11, 2NT=12
- 3. $2 \triangleq 11$ or a long minor, 2NT=12

Bids that are artificial or have a potentially unexpected meaning are alertable*

Option 1: 2 shows a long minor

In response to 1NT, $2 \spadesuit$ shows a long minor. Opener **must** rebid $3 \clubsuit$. Responder will pass or convert to $3 \spadesuit$.

If you have 11-12pts with one or more 4-card major, you should normally use Stayman, so cannot use 2♠=11, 2NT=12

Option 3: 2 = 11 or a long minor

Combines the first two schemes:

In response to 1NT, 2 h shows either 11pts or a long minor

Opener **must** rebid as follows:

2NT with 12-13pts

3. with exactly 14pts (a maximum)
