4-3 Trump Fits Can be Troublesome

Difficult Contracts

- Sometimes bridge declarers find themselves in a contract that seems impossible. There is one piece of advice that every master bridge player will give you. "Don't Panic."
 - If the contract is truly impossible, then you will go down. That happens!
 - But if you take a step back and don't panic, you may find there's a way to make the contract.

The Moysian Fit

- The Moysian fit is named for a famous bridge player and writer, Alphonse Moyse.
- It is a 4-3 trump fit.
- The Moysian fit can be tricky to play, but if you keep your head, you can often succeed.

How do we get into a Moysian Fit?

- One way is that partner might feel the need to support you with 3 cards.
- 1 ♦ ...pass .. 1 ♠ ...2 ♣ ...2 ♠
- 2 ★ ...double ...3 ★... 4 ♥
- There are other ways, but these are two common ones.

Guidelines for Playing a Moysian Fit

- Ideally, the hand with 3 trump will also be short in another suit, so the three trump can be used to ruff declarer's losers.
- You must try to avoid ruffing in the hand with 4 trump unless you can play the hand as a total cross-ruff.
- Sometimes, you can pull all the trump and play the hand as no trump, but of course that means you must have all suits controlled.

More Guidelines

- When you do pull trump, you must decide how many rounds you can pull safely.
- You often need to keep some trump in both hands, until the hand is set up, as a protection against the opponents forcing you to ruff in the hand with 4 trump.
- Usually, you will have to play the opposing trump to split no worse than 4-2
