The Gazzilli Convention By Neil H. Timm

The 2/1 Game Force System is an improvement over the Standard American System. The advantage of the 2/1 System is that it allows the partnership to know that game is possible with only a single 2-level suit bid. The 2/1 auctions are: $1 \diamondsuit -2 \diamondsuit$, $1 \diamondsuit -2 \diamondsuit$, $1 \diamondsuit -2 \diamondsuit$, and $1 \diamondsuit -2 \diamondsuit$ and are game force (GF) bids.

However, what is one to do over a MAJOR suit bid if it is followed by a 1-level bid (1-over-1 bids)? More precisely how do you make a forcing 2/1 bid with the bidding sequences: 1M-1NT or $1\Psi-1A$.

One may play the Gazzilli convention; in both of these bidding sequences, a 24 rebid by opener is a 2-way bid showing one of two types of hands:

- 17+HCP, any distribution
- less than 17HCP

Responder is required to make the relay bid of 2♦ with 8+HCP and any distribution. Any other bid shows less than 8HCP and is natural. In general preference should be given to the major with only a doubleton and less than 8HCP.

Opener will now clarify his hand:

After 1M-1NT-2♣-2♦ or 1♥-1♠-2♣-2♦, opener rebids 2M with the weak version. Any other bid shows 17+HCP and makes the auction a GF. Bidding TWO of the other major shows a 3-card support and makes finding a 5-3 or 6-2 fits easy.

After any weak bid, opener will usually pass. With 16-17HCP and a misfit he'll also pass. With a very strong hand opener may bid a new suit. With a fit he can still invite or bid game.

The basic structure of the bids after opener's bid of 24 is:

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The Gazzilli convention is very useful for hands too weak for a 3-level GF reverse but too strong for a minimum rebid at the 2 level: especially those 15-17 hands with a bad suit, that do not want to jump rebid at the 3 level.

Using Gazzilli, one may give up puppet/muppet bids for strong 1NT(15-17) hands with a 5 card major, since the rebids are no longer a problem.

Many pairs in Italy use the Gazzilli 24 for ALL strong 1M openings: that frees the jump to 3 of a suit and 2NT rebid for distributional hands.

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Gazzilli

Playing a so-called standard bidding system, the player opens one of a Major suit and, without competition, the partner responds 1 No Trump. Now if you have a Major single suiter game-forcing hand, there is no convenient bid in several of the standard bidding systems. The player might jump to three of a Minor suit to force the bidding, but that will mean that the responder will not know whether the new suit contains 3 or 4 or 5 cards. Also when the player jumps to the three level with a game-forcing holding with 5-4-3-1 distribution, it becomes difficult to find the fit in your 3-card suit if the responder has that suit in a weak holding. The jump rebid has consumed much of the bidding space, which is of paramount importance for exploring and finding the correct and maximum contract.

Similarly another problem area for standard bidders is balanced holdings of 15-17 high card points containing a 5-card Major suit. If the player opens one of a Major suit, there is a rebid problem with these holdings. Many of the players today open 1 No Trump with a 5-card Major suit to solve this problem. However this creates an additional problem as the partnership might miss out on a 5-4 or a 5-3 Major suit fit on borderline holdings.

To solve all these difficulties and also to allow non-forcing jumps to the three level with fewer high card points (14-16), the Gazzilli conventional method has been developed. The exact origin is somewhat clouded, but the agreement is that this method was devised in Italy.

A) What is Gazzilli

Gazzilli is an artificial bid of $2\clubsuit$ by the opener generally after an opening bid of $1\blacktriangledown$ or $1\clubsuit$ and a response of $1\spadesuit$ or 1NT. The $2\clubsuit$ response is forcing, but the partnership will normally not play in a Minor suit unless no other option is available. The $2\clubsuit$ bid is employed for the following kinds of holdings:

5-3-3-2 hands of 12-14, 15-17 and 18-20 high card points.

5 of a Major suit and 4 plus Clubs with 11-16 high card points.

Generally all other hands of 17 plus high card points (single suiter, two-suiter etc.)

The one feature about the Gazzilli conventional method is that the significance of the individual bids and responses may also be decided, altered, modified, or varied by the partnership. This feature also pertains to the meanings of the continuances.

Note: The Gazzilli conventional method may also be played over Minor suit openings, and the Minor suit bidding sequences are shown following the Major suit openings and continuances.

B) Opener's Rebids After a 1 Heart Opening

Since Gazzilli covers most of the holdings containing 17 plus high card points, it allows the partnership a great deal of fexibility with Precision-like jumps. The jumps are no longer forcing and simple bids at the two level (except 2♣) are narrower in high card points. This certainly has an advantage as the responder no longer needs to keep the bidding open. The following are opener's rebids after a 1♥ opening and a 1♠ or 1 No Trump response.

Note: The attempt has been made to present the bidding sequence and the significance of the bids and responses in bold letters in order to assist the reader.

The rebids of the opener, without competition, after the bidding sequence of 1♥ - 1♠ are as follows. The rebids are generally natural in nature, but the introduction of the Gazzilli conventional method is forcing and, via the continuances, the holding is clarified further.

The rebids of the opener after the bidding sequence, without competition, of 1♥ - 1NT are as follows. The 1 No Trump response can have a definite range according to the partnership agreement. One option is to play standard 6-9 high card points and a second option is to play the 1 No Trump Forcing conventional method used in the Two Over One bidding system with a range between 5 plus and 12 minus high card points.

A feature of the Gazzilli conventional method is that a first response of 1 No Trump is generally considered to be forcing for one round. If the partner has previously passed, then the opener may pass this 1 No Trump first response if the contract cannot be improved.

In this particular bidding sequence only the 3♣ rebid by the responder is game forcing.

D) Responder's Rebids and Further Developments After a 1 Heart Opening

As soon as the Gazzilli conventional method has been initiated, then generally the forcing bid is $2 \spadesuit$, which the responder rebids as a relay to request additional information and shows, at the same time, around 7/8 high card points. As soon as the opener has clarified his holding promising 17 plus high card points, then a game force has been established.

The first obligation of the responder is to then limit his holding as quickly as possible via the following guidelines and according to the following bidding sequences.

If the bidding sequence begins with **1 Major - 1 Major - 2** Clubs (Gazzilli) - 2 Diamonds (gameforcing action), then these continuances are shown first.

For the bidding sequence **1 Major - 1 No Trump** - 2 Clubs (Gazzilli) - 2 Diamonds (gameforcing action), then the continuances are shown following.

Note: As a reminder the bidding sequence is in bold letters to assist the reader.

E) Responses and Rebids After a Minor Suit Opening

As long as the partnership agreement is that the Gazzilli conventional method is included, then if the opening bid is a Minor suit on the one level, then the partnership may not employ the 2* rebid as a natural bid, which some partnerships may view as a disadvantage. The agreement is: after opening one of a Minor suit, the rebid of the other Minor suit on the two level is Gazzilli.

Requirements: the 2♣ or 2♦ Gazzilli rebid is employed for the following kinds of holdings:

shows so-called normal holdings with a single-suited Minor and 17 plus high card points.

shows a 4-card Major suit support for partner with 17 plus high card points. (Note: some partnerships agree on 18-19 hcps).

shows an unbalanced holding with 17 plus high card points with a 5-card plus Minor suit.

As a resulting, possibly unintentional side-effect, direct Splinter bids therefore become, per agreement, reserved for all 4-4-4-1 distributional holdings.

Following are several examples of bidding sequences, which are presented with continuances.

2. Bidding Sequences After a 1 Club Opening

If the opening bid is 1 Club, then the rebid of 2 Clubs cannot be the introduction of the Gazzilli conventional method. In this bidding sequence the rebid of 2 Diamonds must therefore act as triggering the Gazzilli conventional method.

Although there are some similarities in the continuances between a Diamond suit opening and a Club suit opening, there are definite discrepancies. The requirements for initiating Gazzilli is repeated here for the convenience of the reader.

Requirements: the 2♣ or 2♦ Gazzilli rebid is employed for the following kinds of holdings:

shows so-called normal holdings with a single-suited Minor and 17 plus high card points

shows a 4-card Major suit support for partner with 17 plus (some partnerships agree on 18-19) high card points

shows an unbalanced holding with 17 plus high card points with a 5-card plus Minor suit

As a resulting, possibly unintentional side-effect, direct Splinter bids therefore become, per agreement, reserved for all 4-4-4-1 distributional holdings.
