
## 1NT Overcall I

Opening notrump bids put the partnership in familiar territory. Responder has an immediate picture of opener's strength and distribution, making it easier to decide both HOW HIGH and WHERE the partnership belongs. Responder also has tools such as Stayman, Jacoby Transfer and Texas Transfer bids. When the opponents open the bidding, we want to keep our notrump structure intact whenever possible. We can do that with few adjustments.<sup>1</sup>

## Requirements for a direct 1NT Overcall

15-18 HCP
1+ stoppers in opponent's suit
Balanced hand


The differences from an opening 1NT and a 1NT overcall are that Overcaller: (1) may have up to 18 HCP; (2) must have at least one stopper in Opener's suit; and, (3) Partner of Overcaller is not required to announce the point range for the 1NT overcall. Here's some examples:



## Systems On

After Partner makes a 1NT overcall and the next hand passes, the requirements for using Stayman or transfers are the same as if Partner opened.

2NT invitational and 3NT bids, without using Stayman or transfers, in advancing a 1NT overcall, may made with 1 point less. E.g., Partner overcalled 1NT after a 1 opening bid; you hold:



You would invite game using 2NT with 8 HE; had Partner opened 1NT you would pass.

Your Partner has overcalled an (opening bid) with 1NT. In the Advance column, write in your call. If your bid is Stayman, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bid column, enter your bids if Partner responds with 2 or your lowest 4-card major. If your bid is a transfer, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Bid column enter your next bid.
