Weak Twos in Three Suits

- 2 - 23+ points, or fewer points with game in your own hand. This is the same as in normal Acol.
- 2 ♦ Weak: 5-10 points, 6 diamonds
- 2♥ Weak: 5-10 points, 6 hearts
- 2 Weak: 5-10 points, 6 spades
- Good Quality 6-card suit (at least 2 honours)
- On BBO you self-alert all these bids:
 ALERT: WEAK or ALERT: STRONG, ARTIFICIAL

Typically need about **16pts** to make game (in a major), or fewer points with a good fit.

If Playing Weak Twos in Three Suits

- Open most 22 point hands with 2* (unless you can bid 2NT)
- Try to respond to one of a suit if you have 5+ points (partner could have up to 21 points).
