## INTERMEDIATE LESSON 3: STUDENT NOTES

## Escape over 1NT Doubled

## Responder's Actions

Pass willing to play 1NT doubled, shows 8+ HCP
XX Shows any single suited hand, 5+ suit

- opener must bid 2ゥ (if the opposition have passed)
- responder then passes with clubs or bids their long suit

2: $\quad$ Shows clubs and a higher suit, $4 / 4$ shape

- opener passes with 3+ clubs or
- bids their next 3+ suit (with a doubleton club )

2. $\quad$ Shows diamonds and a higher suit, $4 / 4$ shape

- opener passes with 3+ diamonds or
- bids their next 3+ suit (with a doubleton diamond)

2v Shows hearts and spades, 4/4 shape

- opener chooses their longer major

2. Shows 5+ spades, slightly better hand than going through $X X$

## General Principles

- The Double from the opposition in principle, means penalty showing at least $15 / 16$ HCP.
- Opener's partner can pass if they have 8+ HCP
- Partner of the doubling hand should only bid if they are very weak.
- If the opponents bid a suit at any time, the responder should pass with relief if weak!
- It is important to understand, when responder shows two 4-card suits, that the partnership is looking for a 4-3 or better fit.
- Opener only bids if they have a doubleton in partner's 1st bid suit. Exception: when responder shows both majors with $2 v$
- If responder has a five and a four card suit, it is better to $X X$ to show the five card suit, rather than trying to show both suits.
