## WHICH SUIT TO RESPOND AFTER AN OPENING OF ONE OF A SUIT

- 1. WITH TWO 5 or 6 CARD SUITS: Respond with the higher ranking suit first
- 2. WITH 4 CARD SUITS: Bid 'up the line' starting with cheapest 4 card suit.

## 3. USUALLY BID A FOUR CARD MAJOR AT THE ONE LEVEL

- It is almost always right to respond with a four card major at the one level if you can.
- It doesn't matter how poor the suit a one level response doesn't promise any suit quality.
- But with 12+ points always bid **longest** suit first.
