BILLY MILLER: When they Double Your Stayman Bid:

Redouble by NT Opener is to play (4 or 5 good clubs)

Any other bid guarantees a Club stopper: 2H (4 hearts & stopper); 2S (4 spades, fewer than 4 hearts and a club stopper); 2D (neither major, WITH a club stopper)

PASS by NT Opener denies a club stopper (and says NOTHING else)

After Pass by NT Opener:

2D by Responder implies garbage stayman hand 3-4-5-1 approximately

2H by Responder is pass or correct (both majors)

2S by Responder shows 5 spades, around 7-8 HCP, singleton somewhere, mildly invitational

3 of a major by Responder is "Reverse Smolen" with 5 in that major and 4 in other major.

REDOUBLE by Responder reinitiates Stayman. Responses by NT Opener are:

2D shows 4 hearts (a transfer)

2H shows 4 spades (transfer)

2S show NO MAJOR

2NT shows both majors, minimum

3C shows both majors, maximum

If Responder has club stopper, can grab a contract from his/her side.
